

## Flannel Receiving Blankets/ Burp Cloths

1. Cut 2 flannel prints into 36" x 36" or cut 42" x 42" (size of width of fabric) cutting off selvage.
2. Open the fabric and put right sides together.
3. Round the corners of the receiving blanket with a rotary cutter or scissors trimming the edges. (Hint: use an 8" plate to make curve.) Or leave the corners square
4. With right sides together stitch  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam around entire blanket leaving a 3" opening.
5. Turn right side out and press.
6. Topstitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge around entire blanket.
7. Mark a square approximately 16" x 16" centered in the middle of the blanket. Stitch around the square (this keeps the blanket together after washing).



Note: If there is at least a 10" width left over after cutting out the blanket, cut evenly into 2 burp cloth size pieces. Sew burp cloth same method as blanket.
